C. Faith M. Battles Assistant Agency Director Administrative Updates

AB 2449 reiterates the standard Brown Act teleconference rules, recodifies the rules set out in AB 361 for times of declared emergency, and also provides for relaxed teleconferencing rules when a member of the board/commission needs to attend remotely for an emergency, or other reasons supported by "just cause."

Newly Added Teleconference Rules Available Jan. 1, 2023

Under the new teleconference rules, a board/commission may hold a "hybrid" (partial teleconference, partial in-person) meeting without having to comply with certain procedural requirements (post agendas at teleconference locations, identify teleconference locations in the agenda, make all teleconference locations open to the public) in the following limited circumstances:

 One or more members of the board/commission (but less than a quorum) have "just cause" for not attending the meeting in person.

Just cause is defined as:

- a. childcare or family caregiving need
- b. contagious illness
- c. physical or mental disability need, or
- d. travel while on official public business)
- One or more members of the board/commission (but less than a quorum) experience an emergency circumstance (a physical or family medical emergency that prevents in-person attendance).



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- APS and IHSS are business as usual, and we are not on the chopping block for funding
- High inflation, high interest rates, declines in stock market has slowed our economic recovery in California
- We are not in a recession
- General Fund revenues are going to be \$29.5 billion lower than estimated last year
- Governor proposes to save the General Fund in case of recession
- This means no new spending likely
- IHSS budget includes \$20.5 billion for FY 2023-2024
- Estimated IHSS caseload growth will increase by 4.9% in FY 2023 2024
- The State is out of compliance with the federal government requirement on the Electronic Visit Verification (EVV), and the State will have to pay the fine, per the federal government expectation.

D. Public Authority Updates

Training Updates - presented by Mitzi Richardson

- Jennifer Pardini from Health Insurance Counseling and Advocacy Program (HICAP) will facilitate a training each month on different legal topics
- The Alzheimer's Association is coming back to train IHSS Providers on working with IHSS Recipients living with dementia
 - We have an estate planner to provide trainings this year as well.
 - A monthly IHSS Provider peer support group begins this month, facilitated by Ellen Crayton
 - "Home Health and Hospice Training" will continue as well
 - Public Authority continues recruitment outreach for partners including senior centers
 - Fremont Age Friendly Newsletter featured a blurb on IHSS
 - A presentation for IHSS Providers given by key IHSS staff is pending that includes the following information:
 - Best interviewing & hiring tip
 - How to avoid provider payroll fraud
 - Employee responsibility,
 - When to contact your Social Worker
